The rapture question continues in Acts at Peter's second sermon:

Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you:

Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

Acts 3:19-21

Peter addressed the Jews concerning the death of Jesus. They denied Him and had Him Crucified. And then Jesus Rose from the dead. They were to repent and be converted so that their sins may be blotted out. And God will send Jesus. Whom Heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things.

In the above, Heaven must receive Jesus until the times of restitution of all things and not before, Therefore, Does Jesus come before the tribulation? No, because the times of restitution of all things happens after the tribulation.
